

All-Star Selection Addendum

1. RELL will form all star teams, the BOD will decide on the age group and number of all star teams before the selection of players is chosen.
2. The top 3 winning managers will get the first choice to coach All-Star Teams, if they don't want to coach the opportunity will go to the next in line manager. All-Star Managers and Coaches will only be ones that were rostered coaches in the current season. Non-roasted coaches are not allowed to be rostered all star coaches.
3. All-Star Team selection:
 - a. All-Star Teams are selected through a voting process that includes two different groups (players and majors managers) weighted 50/50.
 - i. For simple math: if 100 players vote and 5 managers vote, then a player's vote is worth 1 point and a manager's vote is worth 20 points.
 - ii. This provides equal weight to players and coaches.
 - b. Each group receives the same ballot with the only difference being how the ballot is titled (Player Ballot and Manager Ballot)
 - c. The ballots shall have all the eligible players listed by name, number, team and league age.
 - d. Every individual voting must circle the 12 players they think should make All-Stars for each team (12U, 11U and 10U)
 - e. No one is allowed to vote on more than one ballot.
 - f. Only Majors players may vote on the players' ballot.
 - g. The ballots will be given to players directly following a game near the end of the regular season. Managers will also be given ballots around the same time.
 - h. A committee should be formed to tally and report the results of the ballots.
 - i. All tally data and ballots must be saved to present to the BOD.
 - j. The 9 players receiving the highest point totals will automatically make a team. The remaining spots for each team will be filled by the All Star Manager from those players appearing on the ballot based upon talent and other factors, such as position fit, attitude, and effort.
4. For players to be considered eligible for the All-Stars, they must be eligible and available for the duration of the tournament (review the Little League Rule Book for details) and otherwise be eligible according to Little League Rules.
5. To enforce rule #4 the BOD will have the opportunity to remove players who miss two days of practice within the first week of All-Star practices. The manager must replace the player with one of the players chosen as an alternate at the selection meeting.
